- (d) "By Kids for Kids"

(2) The station's entire broadcast day as a compilation.

(3) Syndicated programs for which WPLG is the copyright holder of exclusive exhibition rights against other broadcast stations carried by a cable system in the WPLG market area as a distant retransmission, including but not limited to:

- (a) Various off network, made for TV, syndicated programs by film and tape.
- (b) Various motion pictures.

(4) Sports event broadcast by WPLG.


